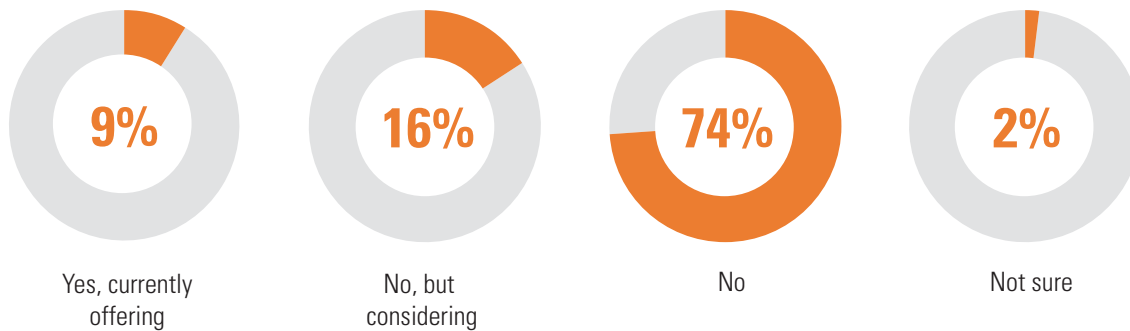


# Student Loan Repayment Assistance Benefits: August 2022 Pulse Survey

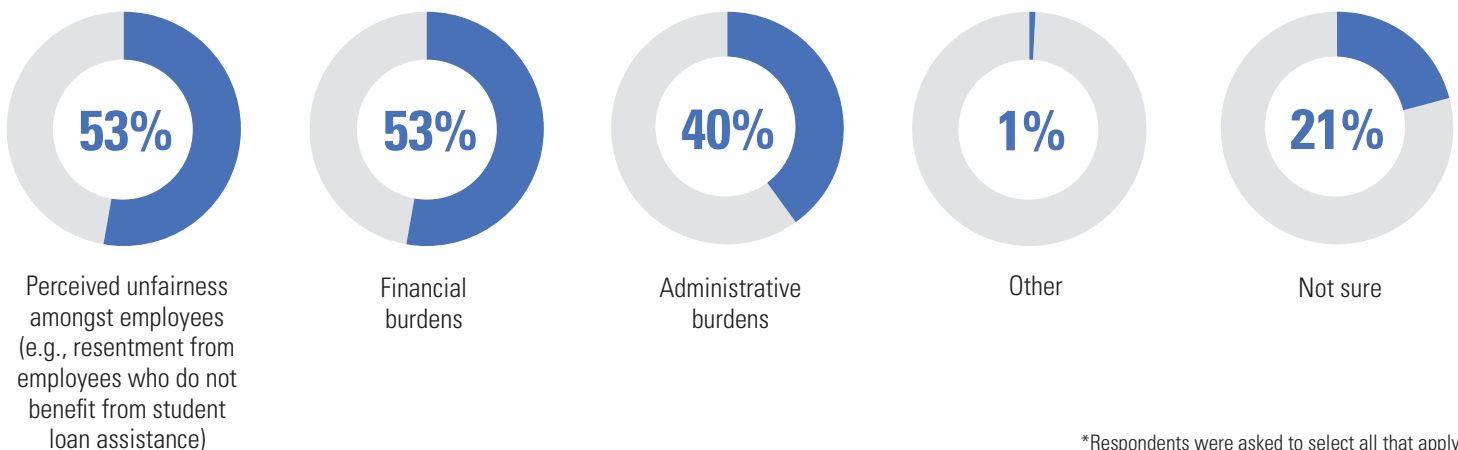
On August 24, 2022, President Biden announced a three-part plan to provide student debt relief, including canceling up to \$20,000 of debt for borrowers who make less than \$125,000 annually. The new relief plan may affect organizations' considerations for student loan benefits. This pulse survey helps plan sponsors navigate the changing landscape and benchmark their plans against what other organizations are offering or planning for the future. View survey results below.



## Organizations Currently Offering Student Loan Repayment Assistance Benefits (n=337)

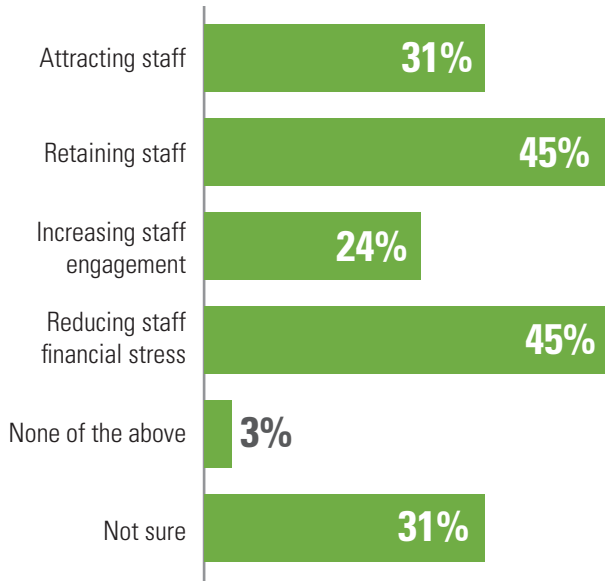


## Current/Potential Challenges Faced by Offering/Considering Student Loan Repayment Assistance Benefits\* (n=337)



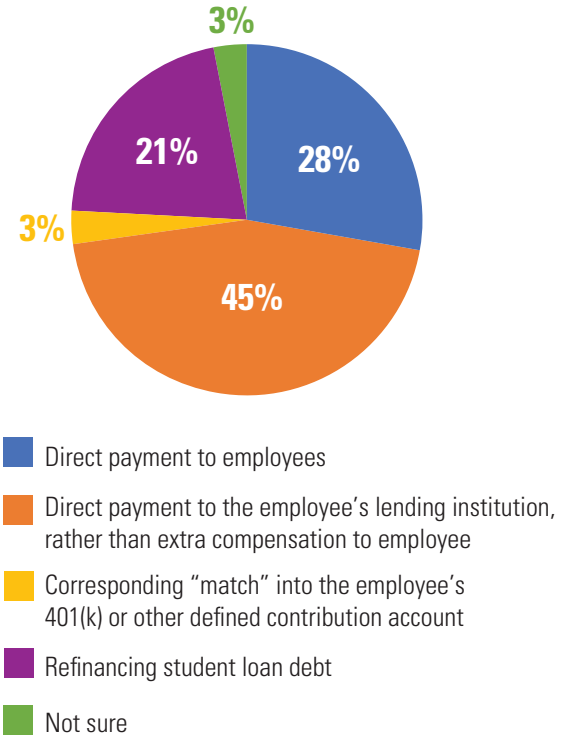

### Benefit Success in Achieving Specific Goals\* (n=29)

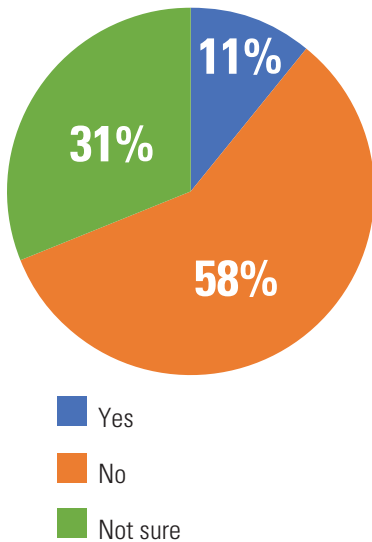
